Our tour will give us a glimpse of the rich history of the oldest winery in the Finger Lakes. Dinner at the **NEW YORK KITCHEN**, for a unique educational experience. Enjoy our 3 course dinner in a demonstration theater setting where we'll watch our chef prepare a dessert.

Day 3: We head for home this morning and enjoy the scenic beauty of the Mohawk Valley along the way.
