

Water & Oil Color Instruction Classes with Lynette Goric
at the Ellington Senior Center

What to Bring:

For the first class, bring what you have. If you have nothing, Lynette will share her paints and brushes, and will let you know what to get for the next class. She will have canvas and paper available to purchase at class, “fairly inexpensive”. If you would like to come prepared, and know which medium (water or oil) you would like to work in, Lynette suggests the following:

Oil Painting:

- A small canvas – can be purchased at a craft store such as Joanne’s, Michael’s, etc.
- Water-soluble oils

Water Colors:

- A small pack of water colors, in the tube
- Paper: (1) 40 lb cold press Arches

Generally, oil painting will be a little more costly for the supplies than water colors, (ballpark for oils is about \$30 to get started).

What to Expect:

The first class Lynette will be giving a demonstration of techniques on a particular piece. You will have a choice to work on replicating the piece Lynette uses for the demonstration, or you can do something you want. She is very flexible.
